

2013 RESIDENTIAL BRUSH & BULK COLLECTION

5 a.m. Monday the week of:

December 31 (2012) April 29 September 9
February 4 June 3 October 7
March 4 July 8 November 4
April 1 August 5 December 9

NOTES

- Place on curb (not on grass) by 5 AM the Monday of the week of scheduled brush collection.
- Place your tree cuttings in a neat, bundled pile with all cut ends facing the same direction.
- Contain small brush cuttings, grass clippings, leaves and palm skins in boxes or bags weighing less than 60 pounds.
- Contain all cactus in covered boxes weighing 60 pounds or less each.

- Entertainment Equipment: Cameras, Televisions, Recorders (VHS and DVR) DVD Players and Stereo Equipment.

NOT ACCEPTED

Air Conditioners, Can Openers, Coffee Pots, Microwaves, Stoves & Ovens, Refrigerators, Washers & Dryers and Hot Water Heaters. No discarded light bulbs will be accepted. No commercial materials will be accepted.

Tires, Appliances, Ammunition, Medical Waste, Landscape Waste, Explosive Material, Radioactive Material

Cardboard Chipboard	Corrugated Cardboard Boxes, Dry Food Boxes (cake, cereal, cracker with no liner), tissue rolls, pizza boxes & Shoe Boxes	No Packing Material, Bar Soap or Detergent Boxes, Wax / Plastic Liners
Glass	Glass Food and Beverage Containers (clear, green or amber)	No Light Bulbs, No Window Glass, Mirror Glass, Ceramics or Pottery
Magazines	All Magazines and Telephone Books	No Paperback or Hardbound Books
Metal Cans	Food Cans made of Steel or Tin, Aerosol Cans (empty only please)	No Other Metals, No paint cans or toxic materials
Newspaper	Newspaper and All Inserts	No Plastic Bags or Rubber Bands
Paper	Computer and Writing Paper, Junk Mail, Brown Paper Grocery Bags, File Folders	No Facial or Toilet Tissue, No Paper Towels or Plates, Napkins, Gift Wrap, Diapers, No Pet Food Bags, No FedEx or Self- sealing Envelopes
Plastics	All Plastic Jugs and Bottles With Screw-top Lids or the Base larger than the Neck, Regardless of Recycling #	No Plastic Bags*, Motor Oil or Pool Chemical Containers, No Plastic Cups or Clear Food Containers, No Styrofoam

^{*} Clear plastic bags can be used to contain shredded paper.
